

To Interested Parties:

RESIDENTIAL IRRIGATION WATER METERS

Requirements:

- A. Meter purchase cost is \$150.00 for ¾” meter. A meter may be installed in the home; on the branch line to the outside spigot, or outside at existing hose bib location.
- B. An employee of the City Water Department will inspect all work after completion and on some installation will install a remote Read-O-Matic onto the home.
- C. The City does not install irrigation meters or pit assemblies. We strongly recommend a qualified plumber for installations. In the event you or your plumber incur or create a water problem, you shall be liable and incur all cost to remedy.
- D. A vacuum breaker shall be installed on all outside irrigation spigots and maintained thereof. Not maintaining a vacuum breaker will be cause for shut off of your total water service.
- E. Show this form and receipt to a DPW Employee at the City Garage to receive your irrigation meter.
- F. You will continue to receive, and be required to pay, a quarterly bill that reflects your total water/sewer usage. At least once per year at the end of the irrigation season you will receive either a sewer credit on your bill or a reimbursement check for sewer not used.
- G. All fees paid at the City Clerk/Treasurer’s Office.
