Important Deadlines

- October 10, 2017 – Last day to register for May Election
 - Any person may register at any Secretary of State Branch Office, at the Clerk's Office, or by mail. IMPORTANT: If you register by mail, you MUST vote in person for your first election. This does not apply to persons 60 years of age or older.
- November 4, 2017 2pm – Last day to request an AV ballot by mail
- November 6, 2017 4 pm – Last date to vote AV at the Clerk's office

Absent Voter Information (AV)

All voters who receive an AV ballot in person at the Clerk's Office must present a photo ID or sign an affidavit. If the voter signs the affidavit, his/her AV ballot must be prepared as a challenged ballot.

You are eligible for an absentee ballot if you meet any of the following criteria:

- Are 60 years of age or older
- Are physically unable to attend the polls without assistance of another
- Are appointed as a precinct worker in a precinct other than your own
- Except to be absent from the community in which you are registered on election day
- Cannot attend the polls because of the tenants of your religion
- Cannot attend the polls because you are confined to jail awaiting arraignment or trial

Completed ballots must be received by the close of polls and can be mailed (\$.68 postage), hand delivered to the Clerk's Office or placed in the City's drop box located on the side of City Hall.

Permanent Absent Voter Application List

The City of East Jordan maintains a Permanent Absent Voter Application List for registered voters who elect to automatically receive an application for an Absent Voter Ballot prior to each election. If you would like to be placed on this mailing list, please contact the Clerk's Office.
